'04 – '07 Prius

Introduction

Some 2004–2007 model year Prius vehicles may exhibit a squeak–type noise when pressing or releasing the brake pedal. This noise may only be audible when the vehicle is in "READY" mode and the vehicle is not moving. Brake system performance is not affected by this noise. Use the following procedure to address this concern.

Repair Procedure

- 1. Confirm noise condition by pressing/releasing the brake pedal.
- 2. Bleed the brake system.

Refer to the Technical Information System (TIS):

- **2004** or **2005** model year Prius Repair Manual, *Brake Brake System "Brake Fluid: Bleeding"*.
- **2006** or **2007** model year Prius Repair Manual, *Brake System "Brake: Brake Fluid: Bleeding".*

If the noise is NO longer present when pressing/releasing the brake pedal, the repair is complete.

If the noise is still present, go to step 3.

- If the noise is still present, replace the Brake Actuator Assembly. Refer to TIS:
 - **2004** or **2005** model year Prius Repair Manual, *Brake Brake Control/Dynamic Control System "Brake Actuator ASSY: Replacement".*
 - 2006 or 2007 model year Prius Repair Manual, Brake Brake Control/Dynamic Control System "Brake Control: Brake Actuator: Replacement
- 4. Road test for proper operation.
